REGISTRATION DEADLINE: September 17, 2011. Entries received after this date will be registered on a space available basis and riders will have to pay a \$10 surcharge per class. This surcharge will NOT apply to adds or drops made during the show by riders who got their paperwork in before the deadline. Paperwork may be submitted by email or by mail, but checks must be received by the deadline in order to benefit from the lower fee. If you can not decide which classes you wish to ride before the deadline, a non-refundable deposit of \$100 must be received no later than the registration deadline in order to benefit from the lower class fees. RIDERS IN INDIVIDUAL OPEN CLASSES WHO FAIL TO GET THEIR ENTRY FORMS IN BY THE DEADLINE WILL RIDE FIRST.

USIHC Competition and FIPO Rules will apply at this show (see [www.icelandics.org](http://www.icelandics.org)). All entries must be accompanied by a copy of the horse's registration certificate issued by a FEIF recognized registry. A \$25 fee will be assessed for each horse NOT registered with the USIHC or any owner and/or rider who is not a USIHC member<sup>1</sup>. All riders and owners will be asked to execute a Waiver of Liability and Agreement and Stable Rules in the attached forms. Please execute a separate form for each horse and for each rider.

### **Statute in Full:**

(a) As used in this section:

(1) "Equine" means a horse, pony, mule or donkey.

(2) "Equine activity" includes but is not limited to:

(A) Equine shows, fairs, competitions, performances or parades that involve any or all breeds of equines and any of the equine disciplines, including but not limited to dressage, hunter and jumper horse shows, Grand Prix jumping, three-day events, combined training, rodeos, riding, driving, pulling, cutting, polo, steeplechasing, English and western performance riding, endurance trail riding, gymkhana games and hunting;

(B) Equine training or teaching activities, or both;

(C) Rides, trips, or hunts.

(3) "Equine activity sponsor" means an individual, group, club, organized camp, club, partnership or corporation, whether or not the sponsor is operating for profit or nonprofit, which sponsors, organizes or provides the facilities for an equine activity, including but

not limited to pony clubs, 4-H clubs, hunt clubs, riding clubs, school and college-sponsored classes, programs and activities, therapeutic riding programs, stable and farm owners and operators, instructors and promoters or equine facilities, including but not limited to farms, stables, clubhouses, pony ride strings, fairs and arenas at which the activity is held.

(4) "Participant" means any person, whether amateur or professional, who engages in an equine activity, whether or not a fee or other consideration is paid to participate in the equine activity.

(b) No person shall be liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, insofar as those risks are necessary to the equine activity and obvious to the person injured.

(1) An equine activity sponsor may post and maintain signs which contain the warning notice specified in this subsection. Such signs shall be placed in a clearly visible location in the proximity of the equine activity. The warning notice shall appear on the sign in black letters, with each letter to be a minimum of one inch in height.

(2) Every written contract entered into by an equine activity sponsor for the providing of professional services, instruction or the rental of equipment or tack or an equine to a participant, whether or not the contract involves equine activities on or off the location or site of the equine professional's business, may contain in clearly readable print the warning notice.

(3) The signs and contracts described in this subsection shall contain the following warning notice:

#### WARNING

Silver Maple Icelandic Horse Farm  
Stable Rules

1. Silver Maple Icelandic Horse Farm is a private facility. Visitors must obtain permission before visiting the facility.
2. All riders, owners and guests must complete and sign a waiver of liability agreement prior to riding or participating in any equine activity. Equine activities include grooming, riding, visiting paddocks, trail rides, lunging, training, and any other activity involving horses.
3. Stable hours are 8-5 PM, Tuesday through Sunday. Hours may vary with management approval.
4. No driving permitted on the premises except to park cars and/or trailers in designated parking areas.
5. Animals are not to be fed or handled without permission of management.
6. Absolutely no smoking in any building. Smoking is only permitted at least 10 feet away from any building or hayfield. All cigarette butts must be disposed of in proper receptacles. No guest or visitor is permitted on the premises while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
7. No children under the age of 14 may be left unattended. All children must be supervised.
8. Running is not permitted in the stable barn or around the horses.
9. Dogs are only permitted on the property if they remain in their cars (with proper ventilation) or are on a leash.
10. Owners, riders and guests are responsible for cleaning up after their horses.
11. All equipment must be returned to the tack room. Each rider or boarder is responsible for maintaining their tack areas neat and clean. Management is not responsible for lost tack or grooming equipment.
12. No property on the premises may be removed without management permission.
13. Helmets must be worn at all times while riding. Proper pants, boots and/or riding shoes must be worn. Riders should ensure that loose clothing be free of snaps, strings or other emoluments that may catch on the horse and pose a risk to the rider or horse. No sandals, shorts or tennis shoes may be worn.
14. No jumping is permitted without management supervision.

15. Riding on the track requires management approval and/or supervision.
16. Riders are not permitted to ride pace without management approval. Riders under the age of 14 are not permitted to ride pace without express parental permission.
17. Boarder feed and supplements must be provided in clean, properly labeled containers indicating the daily feed amount as well as any other pertinent instructions.
18. Management may close the arenas for maintenance as required.
19. All boarders are responsible for damage to stalls, fencing, corrals, feeders, lockers, tack and any other item or area that may be damaged by their horse.
20. All equipment must be placed back in storage following use.
21. ANY violation of these rules may result in being asked to leave the premises.
